Disconnect a network drive from command line

You can disconnect a network drive directly from command line.

For Windows

Follow these steps :

- Use combination of keys 
- type "**cmd**" and press "**enter**".
- type "**net use z: /delete**" (**Z is the letter of drive**).

Press **enter** again.

- Windows confirm that the drive has been disconnected.
